Camp Coordinator – *Mon. May 3rd – Sun. Aug. 22nd*. Applicant must be a minimum of 21 years of age, have a valid driver's license and be First Aid and C.P.R. certified. Responsibilities include managing staff and volunteers and overseeing all camp operations, promoting camp programs with the other staff and the Program & Leadership Committee of the Board, and running camp in accordance with the United Church Camp Standards Guidelines. Office and organizational skills and leadership experience in a residential camp is preferred. The applicant should have Christian ideals, be able to work with minimal supervision, and relate to people of all ages. **Salary \$420/wk.**

Program Director – *Mon. May 3rd – Sun. Aug. 22nd*. Applicant must be a minimum of 18 years of age, have had camp experience and show leadership planning programs and themes with other leaders. Responsibilities include leadership of games and crafts for large or small groups of children of all ages, lead team meetings as required, assist Coordinator as necessary, and must have First Aid and C.P.R. **Salary \$400/wk.**

Youth Worship/Activity Leader/First Aid Attendant – *Mon. June 14th – Sun. Aug. 22nd*. Applicant must be a minimum of 18 years of age hold Christian ideals and have a basic knowledge of the Bible. Responsibilities are to lead morning devotions with staff and counselors, plan chapel themes and programs with other leaders for the campers, lead games or crafts for large or small groups and keep areas clean and safe. As First Aid Attendant – should have a valid driver's license, administer medications and keep inventory control of the infirmary. **Salary \$390/wk.**

Waterfront Director/Programmer – *Mon. June 21st – Sun. Aug. 22nd*. Applicant must be a minimum of 17 years of age have NLS Certification, First Aid, CPR and canoeing experience. Responsibilities include safety of beach area and aquatic equipment, life guarding and instructing campers on waterfront safety and canoeing, working with other leaders to plan and direct waterfront activities. Be able to help with other camp activities and programs when necessary. **Salary \$380/wk.**

Assistant Water Front Director/Programmer – *Mon. June 21st – Sun. Aug. 22nd*. Applicant must be a minimum of 16 years of age and minimum qualification of Bronze Cross, C.P.R. and First Aid and canoeing experience. Responsibilities include safety of beach area and aquatic equipment, life-guarding, working with other leaders to plan and direct waterfront activities and help with other camper programs when needed. **Salary \$370/wk.**

Caretaker/Assistant Programmer – *Mon. June 14th – Sun. Aug. 22nd*. Applicant must be a minimum of 18 years of age, have a valid driver's license. Must be able to work with minimal supervision and able to operate yard equipment (riding lawn mower, trimmer, chain saw, etc.). Responsibilities include meal preparation, cleanliness and sanitation of kitchen area. Participation in camp programs if time permits is expected. **Salary \$390/wk.**

Assistant Cook – *Mon. June 21st – Sun. Aug. 22nd*. Applicant must be a minimum of 16 years of age and have Food Handlers Level 1. Responsibilities include assisting the cook in menu planning, meal preparation, cooking for large groups and work with other volunteers. Participation in camp programs as time permits is expected. **Salary \$370/wk.**
